Mediation Option

If, on receiving a complaint, it appears to the Director of the Tribunal that it is a case which could be resolved by mediation rather than by investigation, the Director is empowered to ask the complainant and respondent to indicate if they would consider mediation. Mediation is strictly a voluntary process. If either party objects, the Director will not refer the complaint to mediation.

Both parties are asked to indicate by ticking the relevant box below if they would consider mediation. It will be assumed that there is no objection to having the case proceed to mediation if this form is not returned to the Tribunal within 21 days of issue.
